Sculpture Workshop: Share a Model (Nude Model)



Registration opens January 9, 2012

No instruction provided. Sculptors will share the process of sculpting with other sculptors. The workshop is open to all levels. This is a great way to share the cost of a long pose figure model (\$50 per night) to complete a finished sculpture. You may bring your own clay and armatures, or buy water based clay from the Coordinator (\$13. per 25 lb. bag). Participants may work on reliefs, portraits, or full figure.

Ten moveable sculpture stands are available and a room is provided to store work each week. A minimum of 6 artists and a maximum of 10 artists have been set to cover costs for a 6-week pose and for the best use of the classroom space available.
