- Two entries per Artist Member, \$12.00 per piece
- Maximum width size 40" wide (size limit includes frame)
- All works must be completed within the last 3 years
- All works must be original and conceived by the artist
- No reproductions or wet paintings please
- Gallery wrapped canvas works –must have a deep profile stretcher and be stapled on back with gessoed or painted sides
- Acceptable hardware for wood frames: screw-eyes or d-rings
- Acceptable hardware for metal frames: hardware that screws secure in track (not sliding)
- No sawtooth hangers, spring clips, tension mounts, standing photo frames, or pop-in frames
- Please contact the gallery if you have extenuating circumstances and need to make arrangements to deliver or pick-up your entry

### Call for Entry

**Insurance and Artists responsibility:** Works will be handled with all possible care. NAA provides insurance up to 65% of retail value declared by the artist, from the day of receipt of the artwork to the final scheduled pick up of artwork not accepted, work accepted, or delivery of, and payment for, work sold to the buyer. The artist bears all responsibility for loss of, or damage to, work not picked up by the end of the scheduled pick up period. Artists will be charged a \$20 late fee for work left beyond the pick up period, unless prior arrangements are made with the office. Submission of an entry constitutes agreement with all the terms of these shows. NAA takes a 35% commission on sales. NAA is not responsible for work not removed by pick up date. Artist grants rights to use of images for publicity and website listing. Website thumbnails are protected from enlargement. Please provide notification in advance if someone else is picking-up for the artist.
