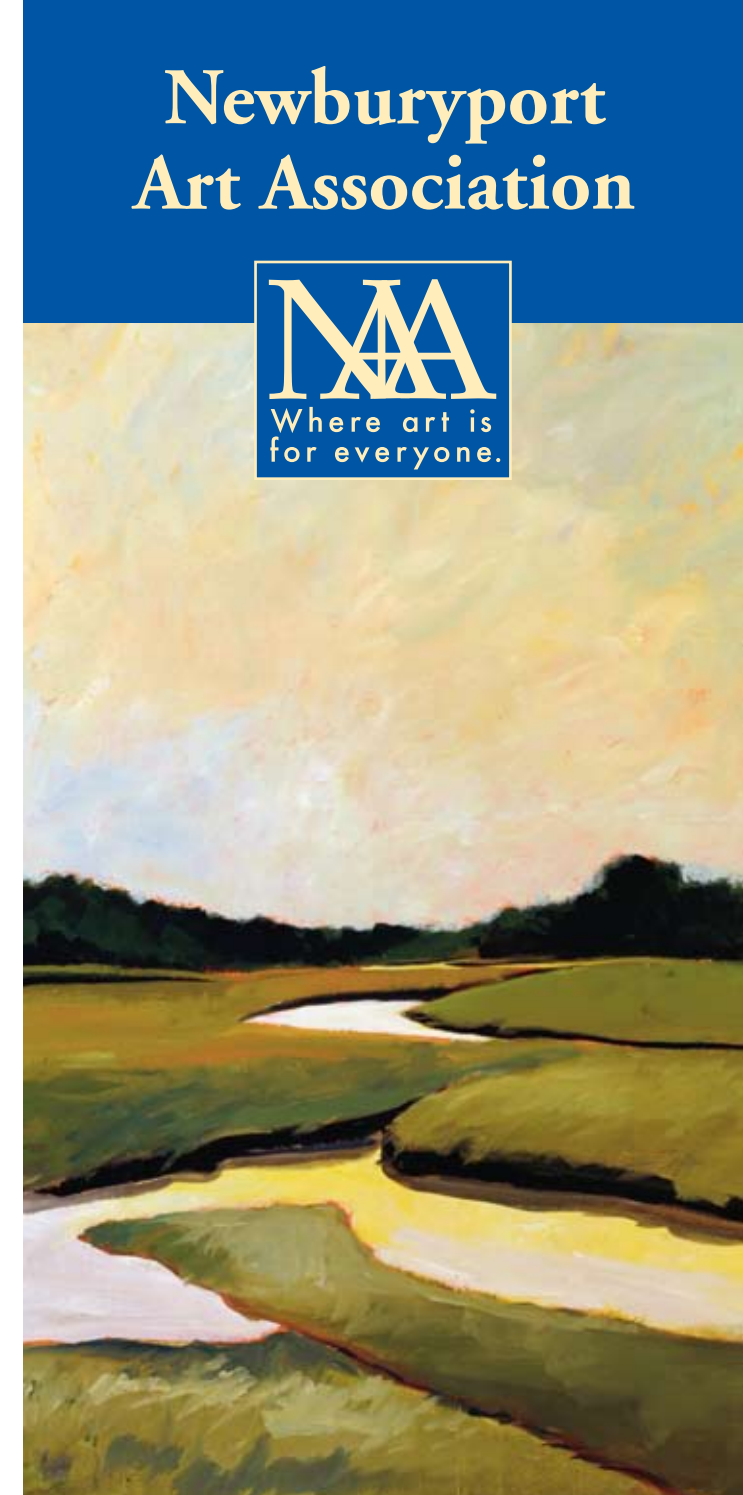

About the NAA

Founded by a small group of artists in 1948 with the purpose of exhibiting and promoting their work, the Newburyport Art Association (NAA) has grown to become one of the largest and most active art associations in the region.

With over 600 members and 30 shows a year, a full calendar of studio classes and workshops, and the launch of two important community outreach programs, the NAA has become a cornerstone of today's vibrant arts scene in the greater Newburyport area.

Our Galleries

Set along Newburyport's picturesque waterfront, and just steps from its center, the NAA's historic 1795 brick building houses three galleries – Sam Sargent, Hartson and Laura Coombs Hills – that are open year-round to the general public. Exhibited art is for sale, and the extensive exhibition schedule covers all visual art media.



The NAA's historic building, built c. 1795, housed a West Indies trade warehouse, a fire door manufacturer, a grocery, a lobster pound, and a pool hall, before finally becoming the NAA in 1969. A neighboring coal weigh station building built c. 1890 was restored and added-on as the Laura Coombs Hills Gallery annex in 2002.

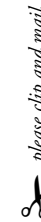

OpArt — A collaboration with the Newburyport Opportunity Works, *OpArt* provides individuals with disabilities hands-on art instruction using different media, techniques and materials, and the chance to realize their life's ambitions through the creative process related to the visual arts.
